1 outside the state of Washington), after the date of service on you of this summons, excluding  
2 the day of service, or a default judgment may be entered against you without notice. A default  
3 judgment is one where the Appellant may be entitled to what is asked for because you have not  
4 responded.

5 4. If you serve a notice of appearance on the undersigned person you are entitled to  
6 notice before a default judgment may be entered.

7 5. If not previously filed, you may demand that the Appellant file this lawsuit with the  
8 court. If you do so your demand must be in writing and must be served upon the undersigned  
9 person. Within 14 days after you serve your demand, the Appellant must file this lawsuit with  
10 the court, or the service on you of this summons and complaint will be void.

11 6. If you wish to seek the advice of a lawyer in this matter, you should do so promptly  
12 so that your written response, if any, may be served on time.

13 7. This summons is issued pursuant to Rule 4 of the Civil Rules for Superior Court of  
14 the State of Washington.
